Additionally, VUM welcomes every year incoming students for studies or placement who are full-time students at one of the more than 80 partner universities of VUM located in near 20 Programme Countries from the EU, Norway and Turkey.

Visa and entry requirements

Erasmus+ students who are citizens of countries outside the EU have to apply for a study visa for Bulgaria prior to their arrival to VUM. VUM provides all necessary documents (Visa Application Letter, Acceptance Letter, Accommodation Confirmation Letter indicating the residence address of the mobile student in Bulgaria) and assists all incoming students throughout the whole process of visa application. - Copy of the student's European Health Insurance Card (EHIC). Non-EU citizens are expected to provide a copy of medical insurance valid for the EU and Bulgaria for the period of the planned Erasmus+ mobility.

Course Load

Each semester corresponds to 30 ECTS.

TUITION AND FEES

Participating students pay applicable tuition fees and student activity fee to their sending institution. They will be exempt from paying tuition fees to the receiving institution. Participating students are liable for visa application costs, travel costs, accommodation, medical insurance, books and supplies, meals, and personal expenditures and neither university shall be held liable for such charges.

Participating students will be subject to and must abide by all the rules and regulations of the receiving institutions and countries.

Medical Insurance

The participant shall have adequate insurance coverage. The participant shall have adequate insurance coverage. A medical insurance valid for the EU member states for the whole period of the trip, covering all costs for repatriation and for urgent medical care and emergency hospital treatment for the period of the stay indicated in the visa is mandatory. The insurance amount cannot be less than 30 thousand euro. The participant is responsible for obtaining the Medical Insurance.

ARRIVAL IN BULGARIA

Transportation

The incoming Erasmus+ students should make sure they get a flight to Varna because the airport in Varna is the closest to Dobrich and we will be able to pick them up from there. If they get a flight to another airport in Bulgaria, we won't be able to provide them transportation to Dobrich because unfortunately the other airports are too far away from Dobrich. The students should also send to VUM Erasmus+ team a clear and readable scanned copy of your flight ticket at least 5 business days prior their arrival to Bulgaria so we can arrange a driver to pick them up from the airport. The price of an organized transfer from Varna airport to Dobrich is 50 BGN that shall be paid on the first working day following the arrival. If they are taking another kind of transportation, the students inform VUM Erasmus+ team about the date, time and place of their arrival 5 business days prior their arrival.

Approximate costs of living in Dobrich on a monthly basis	
Food costs	EUR 100
Accommodation costs (*depend on the room prefecence)	* EUR 10 per day/ per student accommodated in a single room incl. all utility costs. (30 days * EUR 10 = EUR 300)

ACCOMMODATION

VUM Student House Dobrich

During their studies at VUM campus in Dobrich, all Erasmus+ students are accommodated at VUM student house in Dobrich. The student house consists mainly of apartments with 3 bedrooms, kitchen and bathroom. Each bedroom has two or three beds, desks for each student and a bookshelf for each student.

IMPORTANT: The student house can provide you ONLY a pillow, a pillowcase, bedsheets and a blanket. Other necessities have to be bought by the students. Each apartment has one kitchen and one bathroom which are shared by all the students living at the same apartment.

Accommodation prices and payment deadlines:

- a) Student house's security deposit of 80 EUR + deposit of 15 EUR for key and access cards.
- b) Rent including all utility costs for water, electricity, gas and internet:
 - ❖ 7 EUR per day per person in a double (shared) room or
 - ❖ 10 EUR per day per person in a single room.

The payment of both due deposits and the rent for the first month shall be made on the first working day following the arrival. Payment of the rent for each following month shall be made no later than the start of the month.
