- Transcript of records from home institution
- All supporting documents are to be uploaded to the online application form.



Application periods

Spring semester: September 1st – October 15th (nomination deadline Oct. 1st)

Fall semester: February 15th – May 15th (nomination deadline May 1st)

Duration of exchange: 1 – 2 semesters

Application requirements

- Official nomination from home institution
- Completion of at least one year of study
- Continuing towards a degree at home institution
- A solid GPA
- Good English skills, B2 level is recommended
- Signed ECTS Learning Agreement or other confirmation/nomination from school

Visa Requirements

- Students from outside the European Economic Area need to apply for a residence permit before arrival.
- Allow at least 3 months for processing.
- Contact our International Office for assistance.

Insurance

Required for students from outside the European Economic Area and available at a reasonable cost from Icelandic insurance companies. Contact the International Office before your arrival. Not required for European students who have a valid E111 or European health insurance card.

Date

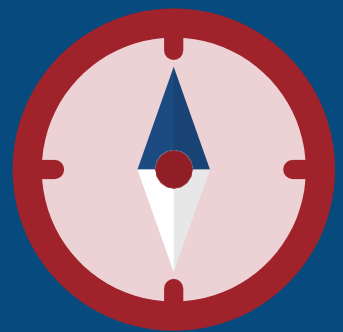
Usually last Friday before start of semester (subject to change with prior notice)

Move-in-date

Exchange students are expected to arrive 1-4 days prior to the orientation day.

Areas of focus

Business, Business Law, Economics, Political Science, Philosophy

Language of instruction

Mostly Icelandic, but English for some second- and third-year courses and for exchange students.

Slot system

Each course is taught in 6 week slots and the workload is divided between slot 1 and slot 2. The exams are in the 7th week of each slot.

Grading Scale

Grades are on a 0 to 10 scale.

9.0, 9.5, 10.0 is equivalent to ECTS A

8.0, 8.5 is equivalent to ECTS B

7.0, 7.5 is equivalent to ECTS C

6.0, 6.5 is equivalent to ECTS D

5.0, 5.5 is equivalent to ECTS E

0 - 4.5 is equivalent to ECTS F or FX



ects credits and student workload

ECTS workload

One ECTS credit normally consists of 25–30 hours student workload.

Credits per course

All courses are 6 ECTS

Recommended credit load per semester

30 ECTS (less for students coming during summer semester)

Minimum workload per semester

We do not set a strict minimum, but prefer that exchange students take at least 2/3 of a full load.

Maximum workload per semester

We do not set a strict maximum.

Length of Bachelor degree (in years)

3 years (can be completed in 2.5 years if students take two full summer terms)

Graduation requirements for bachelor degree

180 ECTS, including final thesis

Teaching methods

Lectures, homework assignments, exams, group projects, thesis

- 17 m² room for one person (private bath, kitchen shared by 6 students)

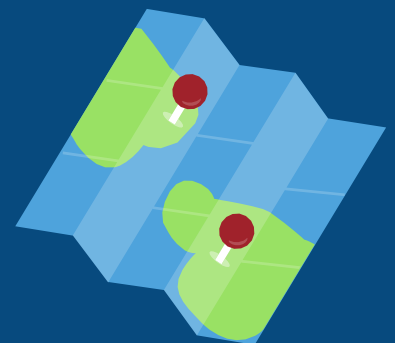
- Rent is at least 400 EUR
