



The English-taught Undergraduate Program of Foreign Affairs @ Jilin University

I Description

This program aims at training internationalized, interdisciplinary talents who are equipped with basic knowledge and theories on diplomacy and related subjects while master certain level of research, fluent foreign language skills. Students will be qualified to perform in the areas of public diplomacy and cultural exchange, policy analysis and international communication, teaching and research in governmental foreign services, education/research institutes, multinational corporations, international organizations, media, etc.

The Undergraduate Program of Foreign Affairs was launched on September 2014, of which 70% of its major courses are taught in English. In 2015 this program was incorporated as one of the Course Reform Pilot Programs of Undergraduate Curriculum Construction Program of Jilin University. “History of International Relations” conducted by Prof. Liu Debin was elected as National High-Quality Course and the 2nd Shared Course Resources initiated by the Ministry of Education.

II Programme Length and Degree Granted

Programme Length: 4 years Degree to be granted: Bachelor's Degree of Law

III Qualifications for the degree

1. The students have to meet the school's cultivation objectives' requirements, and acquire all the required knowledge and ability according to the curriculum.
2. The students have to complete all the courses required by the curriculum, pass all the exams and finish the graduate internship with the credit granted.

3.Accommodation Fees

The room is furnished with desks, bookshelves, wardrobes, television set, a private bathroom and shower.

Single room: 30-50 yuan/person/day

Entry requirements

1.The applicants should be other than Chinese national and hold a valid passport, he or she should be in good health and has no criminal record, and willing to abide by the law of the People's Republic of China and the regulations of Jilin University;

2.The applicants should hold required diploma;

3.The applicants should have adequate English proficiency so as to engage in English-taught program learning.

About School of International and Public Affairs

People around world are getting closer in time and space with much intensified interactions along with the ongoing development of economic globalization and information society. Public diplomacy and cultural exchanges are playing an increasingly significant role in promoting understandings between ethnic groups, cultures, religions and nations, and help improve the international image of a country. The world is entering the Era of Public Diplomacy. On one hand, as a necessary supplement to governmental diplomacy, public diplomacy has been drawing significant attention by countries worldwide and become an integrated part of the overall diplomacy of certain countries; on the other hand, the governments are also actively engaging non-governmental diplomacy to promote the understanding of other people to know the home country.

The Era of Public Diplomacy calls for new type of talents who are versed in communication and dialogue, and have good knowledge of the World Economics, politics and cultural plurality. As an answer to this calling and to promote public diplomacy and cultural exchanges, Jilin University has set up the School of International and Public Affairs (hereinafter referred to as SIPA) which is the first school oriented in public diplomacy studies among Chinese universities. In 2014 SIPA participated as a founding member in the establishment of "Collaborative Innovation Center of the Theory and Practices of China's Diplomacy" initiated by China Foreign Affairs University.

SIPA has constructed a faculty team pivoted in International Relations while specialized in Law, Economics, Journalism, History and Cross-Cultural Communication, etc. Meanwhile, SIPA also includes Barry Buzan who is member of British Academy of Science and a former professor of London School of Economics, Brantly Womack who is the Friendship Award recipient and professor of government and diplomacy in the University of Virginia, etc. as Honorary or Guest Professors.

SIPA combines the training of Chinese students and International students together and adopted English as the working language for main courses. The purpose is to lay out a internationalized and cross culture platform, to promote research in International Relations, Public Diplomacy, International Relations History, English School Theory, and China Studies, etc.

SIPA will steadily uphold the educational ideal of internationalization, inclusiveness, innovation and practice, and will put greater endeavor for the development of public diplomacy disciplines in China.
