Credit System	Boğaziçi University uses a credit-hour system. A typical course is 3 or 4 credits with 3 to 5 hours of contact per week in the form of lectures. In addition, all courses have equivalent ECTS credits, which are indicated in the transcripts.
Credits per semester for full-time Boğaziçi Students	Credits per semester for full-time Boğaziçi Students 15-24 credits, corresponding to 5-6 courses, or approximately 30 ECTS.

Minimum and maximum number of credits that can be taken by Incoming Exchange Students	All exchange students are expected to take a normal semester load (15-24 Boğaziçi credits, or approximately 30 ECTS). This corresponds to 5-6 courses.

- Boğaziçi University uses the “nomination by the home-admission by the host” system. All exchange students are nominated by their home institution. Boğaziçi University, as the host institution, reviews the applications and its individual academic units decide on whether to accept the applicant.
- Each exchange student is registered with an academic unit. The academic unit assigns the academic advisor.
- All exchange students are expected to select at least two courses from the academic unit with which they are registered.

- Original copy of the transcript, in English
- Statement of Purpose: An essay, no more than 300 words, explaining why you would like to attend Boğaziçi University.
- A list of courses you would like to take (a minimum 2 courses should be taken from the host department). Please note that this list is only for the application. Your actual classes will be determined during registration at the beginning of the semester.
- A letter of recommendation.
- Language requirements for all incoming students:
Non-native speakers of English must provide proof of proficiency in the English Language by means of the TOEFL or IELTS. Minimum scores required:
TOEFL: 550 + TWE 4.5 for the paper-based test, 213+ TWE 4.5 for the computer-based test, 79 + TWE 24 for the Internet-based test,
IELTS (6.5).
