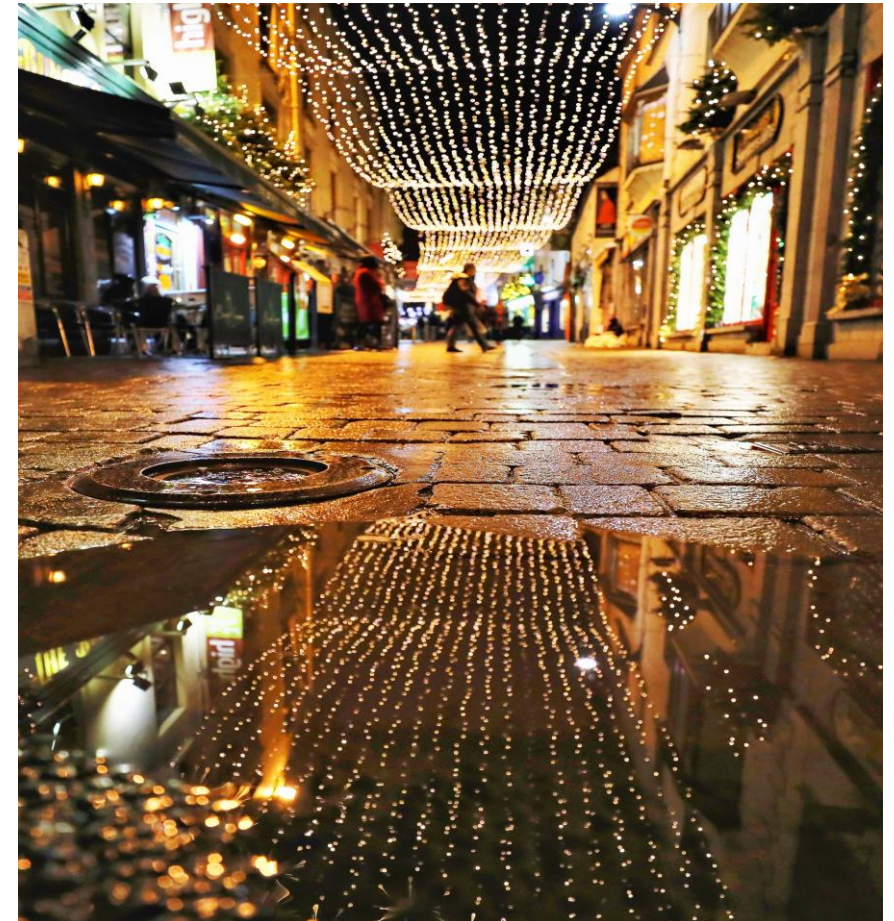

Erasmus at NUI Galway

- Welcoming Erasmus students for over 30 years
- Semester or a full academic year
- (Sept-Dec & Jan-May)
- Large choice of modules to meet individual academic requirements
- Maximum credits per semester: 30 ECTS (6 modules/classes)
- Integrated classes and assessments, alongside domestic students.
- 650 students per year (USA, Canada, Mexico, Hong Kong) + 350 ERASMUS Exchange Students (EU)



How to Apply

- NUI Galway uses an online applications system for incoming Erasmus students.
- A link to the online form will be sent to the e-mail addresses of all students who have been formally nominated by their home universities for Erasmus studies at NUI Galway.
- The closing dates for receipt of applications:
 - 31st May for full academic year or First Semester
 - 31st October for Second SemesterLate applications will not be processed

Entry Requirements

- Normally require two full years at university or college
- Visiting Students given a two week period at the beginning of each semester to sample different classes before making their final selections and a further 'drop/add' week is then allowed
- Certain classes (e.g. Science/Engineering) may have specific pre-requisites so students must indicate specific classes when applying so that they can be assessed.

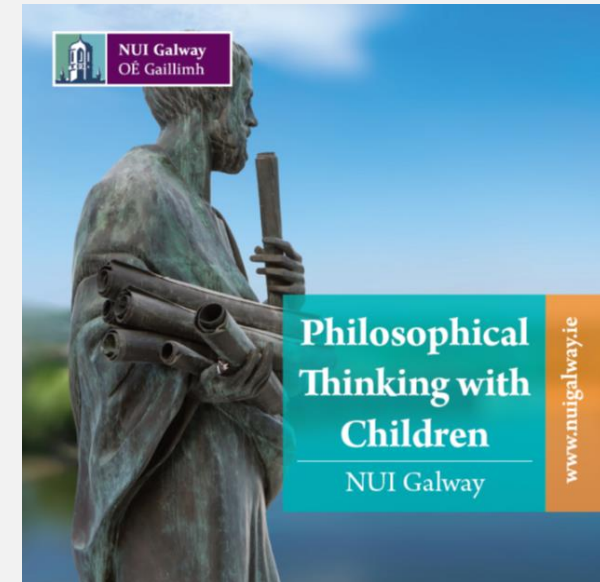

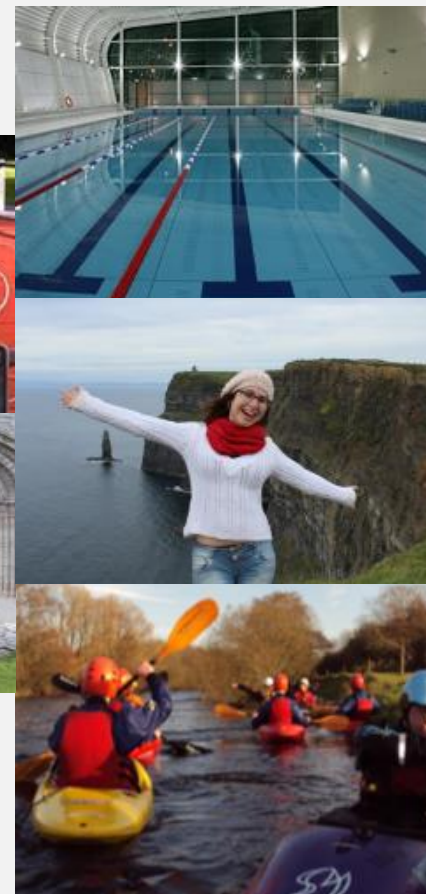


- Corrib Village: Prices range from €3,750 per year to €6,050 per year.
