B2 English
+ mandatory Intensive German course in Sept. or March

Expectable costs



Monthly costs of living	Approx. 750 EUR
Accommodation	between 350 and 500 EUR
Semester ticket for public transport (per semester)	approx. 210 EUR
Semester contribution (per semester; to be payed after arrival)	approx. 120 EUR
Health insurance (compulsory)	approx. 110 EUR
Broadcasting contribution fee (monthly; compulsory)	17,50 EUR
+ other incidental and personal expenses (e.g. university sports, leisure time...)	... EUR

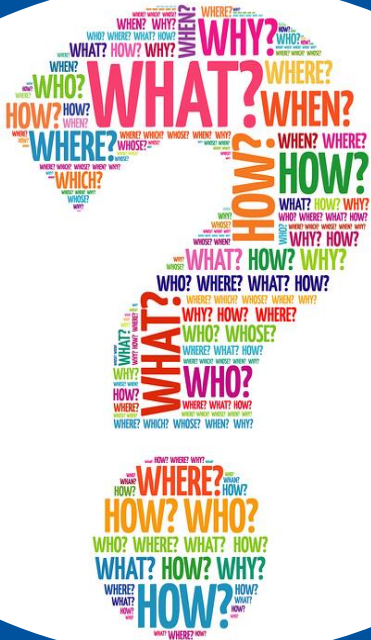


Heidelberg: Neckarsteinach, boat trip and old town of Heidelberg
