Welcome to the University of Deusto



Founded in 1886, the University of Deusto is a Spanish Jesuit University with two campuses located in the heart of the Basque cities of Bilbao and San Sebastián, a site for Executive Education in Madrid and a fourth for Dual training in Vitoria.

Recognised by its international outlook, Deusto is ranked among Spain's leading universities.

Our hallmark is a student-oriented education based on the development of competencies and values, through innovative learning methods.

The Basque Country

The Basque Country is an autonomous community in the north of Spain, bordering Atlantic France and the Pyrenees, and on the coast of the Bay of Biscay.

Two co-official languages are spoken: Spanish and Basque (Euskera).

From the avant-gardism of its cities to the tranquility of its coastal fishing villages, the emblematic landmarks of a magical land called Euskadi invites to discover its history, nature and culture, accompanied by its incomparable enogastronomy.

The Basque Country is one of the most important industrial concentrations in Spain with machinery, aeronautics, automotive and energy as the strongest industrial sectors. New technologies and research and development (R&D) initiatives are also becoming very relevant, as the growing presence of technology parks shows. While the Basque Country has 6% of Spanish population, it represents more than 22% of the industrial I+D+I of the country.



Bilbao campus

The Bilbao campus was declared a site of historical interest in 2002. The campus is located in the **most cosmopolitan** area of Bilbao, on the banks of the river, and surrounded by *avant garde* buildings, such as the Guggenheim Museum, boasting signatures of the world's most prestigious architects.

As the most important and vibrant metropolis in northern Spain, Bilbao has navigated from a strong and heavy industrial past to becoming a worldwide symbol of revitalisation of a city through art, culture and urban transformation. Among many recognitions, Bilbao prides itself with the numerous international awards received such as «**The 2018 European City of the Year**» and «**UNESCO City of Design**» for its input to the global design industry.



San Sebastián campus

The San Sebastián Campus is located in the city centre of one of **the most beautiful coastal cities in Europe**.

San Sebastián shows a dynamic cultural and leisure scene, events ranging from the International Film Festival, to Jazz music and theatre renowned shows all year round. San Sebastián is a dream destination for food lovers who will appreciate the internationally renowned **Basque cuisine**. Culinary culture permeates the social life of the city, from Michelin-star restaurants to hundreds of «pintxo» bars for all tastes and pockets.



Madrid site

The Madrid site of Deusto Business School is situated in a villa **in the heart of the financial and commercial district**, with **classrooms for training courses and teamworking, a library** and an **auditorium**.

It also houses the conference rooms for meetings of the Board of Directors of Deusto Business School.



Vitoria site

The venue of the University of Deusto in the city of Vitoria-Gasteiz, called **Egibide-Deusto** has been the **first centre in Spain to have an industrial plant specifically dedicated to training of students**. Currently the Dual Degree in Digital Industry is being taught on those premises.

Egibide-Deusto counts with more than **8.000 m²** and fully IT equipped classes, WI-FI and specialized labs-workshops on top of the **6.000 m²** of green spaces, sports facilities and parkings.

Deusto at a glance

The University of Deusto covers six main fields of study: Business, Law, Psychology and Education, Theology, Social and Human Sciences and Engineering, offering 43 undergraduate programmes and 78 postgraduate programmes: 44 Master's degree and 8 PhD programmes, among others.

Around 11,000 students, of which 1 out of 5 are grant recipients, are currently studying at this institution with 133 years of experience.

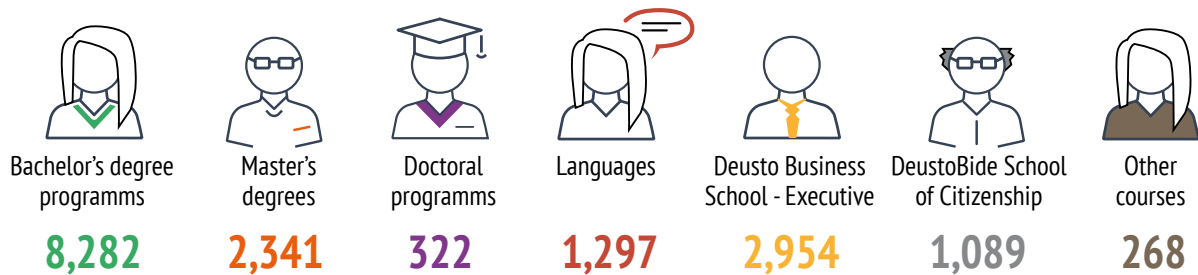

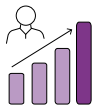

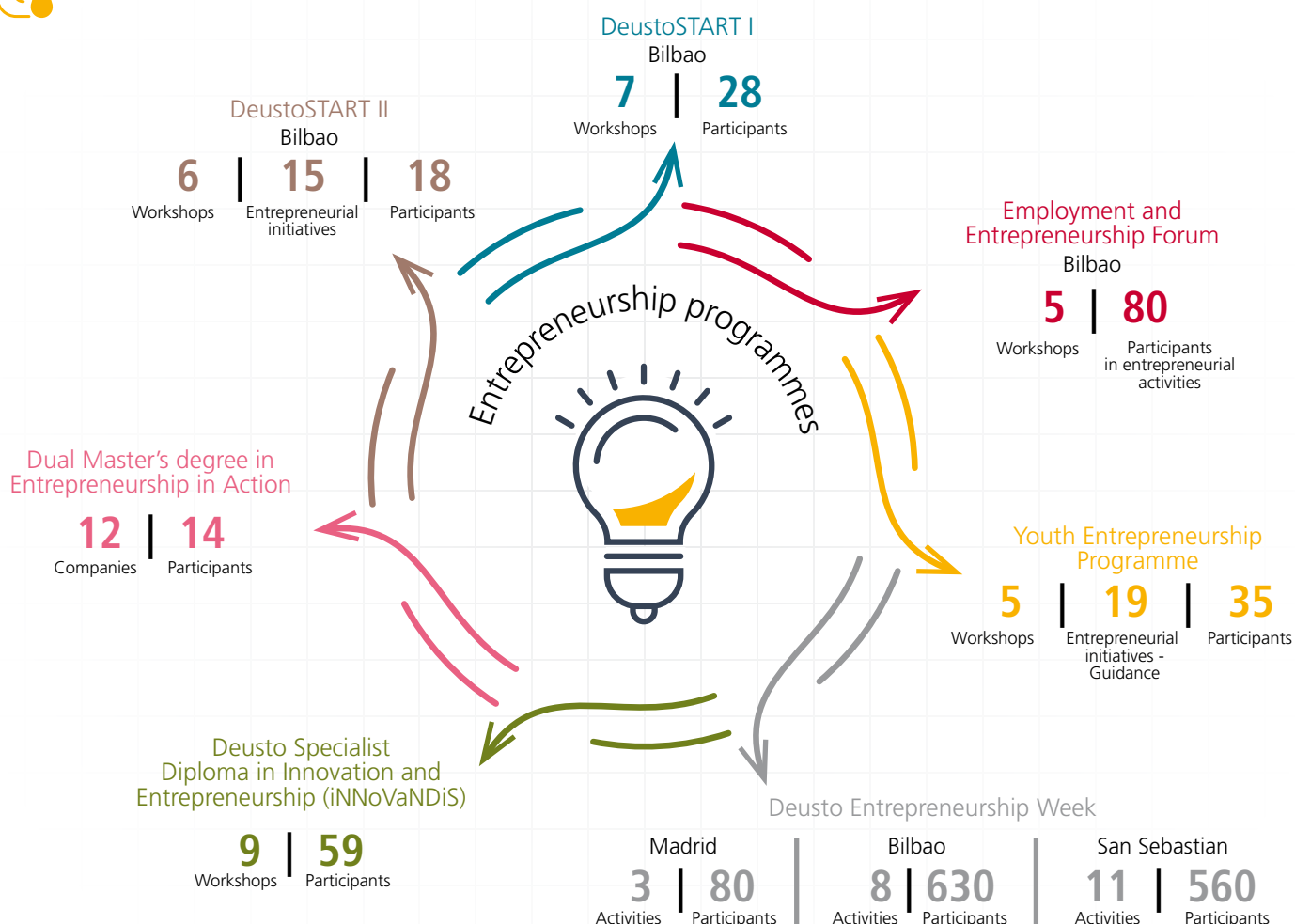
Entrepreneurship

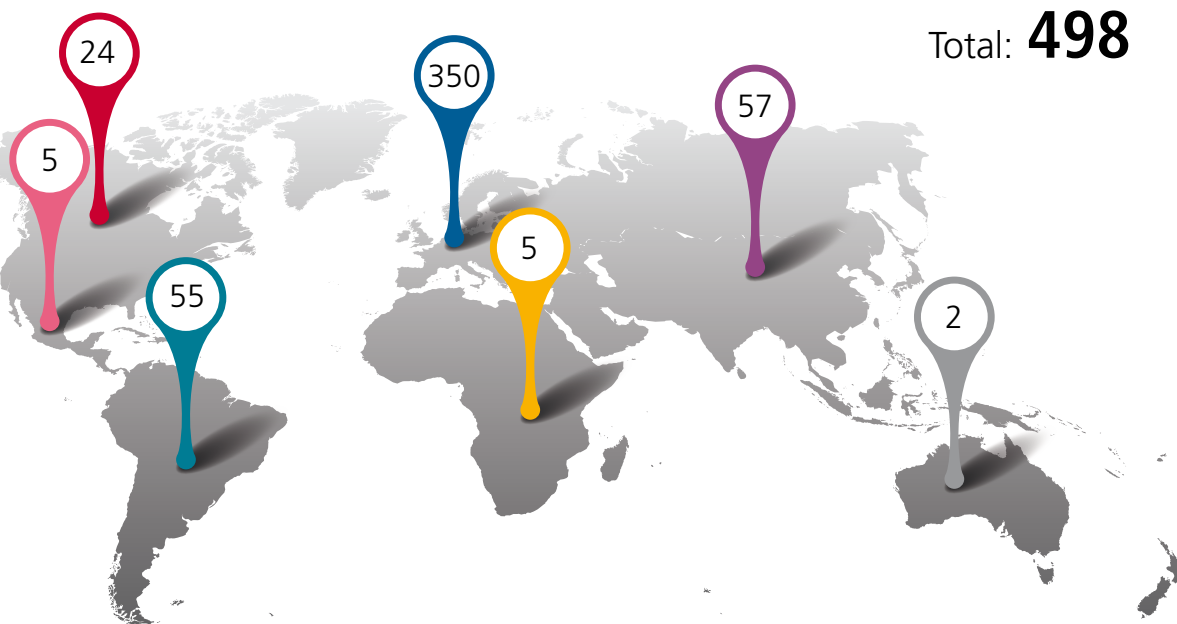

The University of Deusto enhances international cooperation through different types of bilateral agreements that facilitate students and staff mobility all around the world.



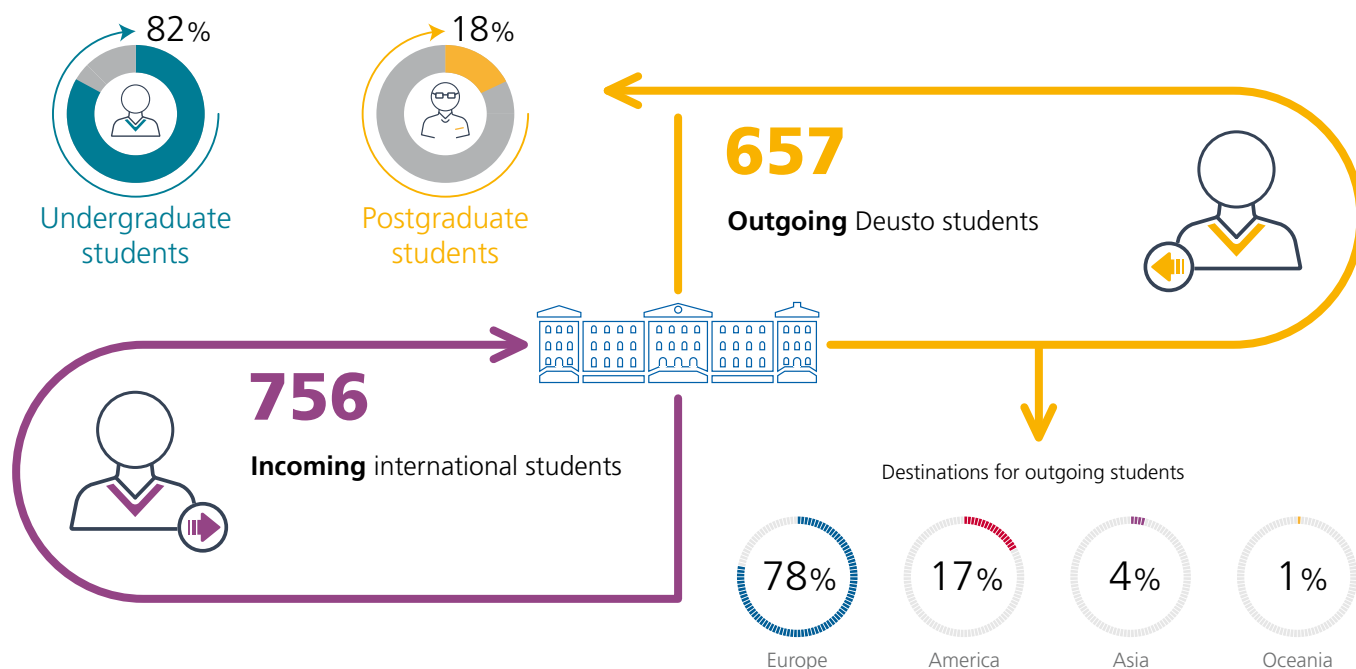
Universities with which Deusto has signed international agreements

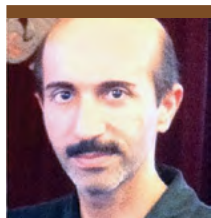

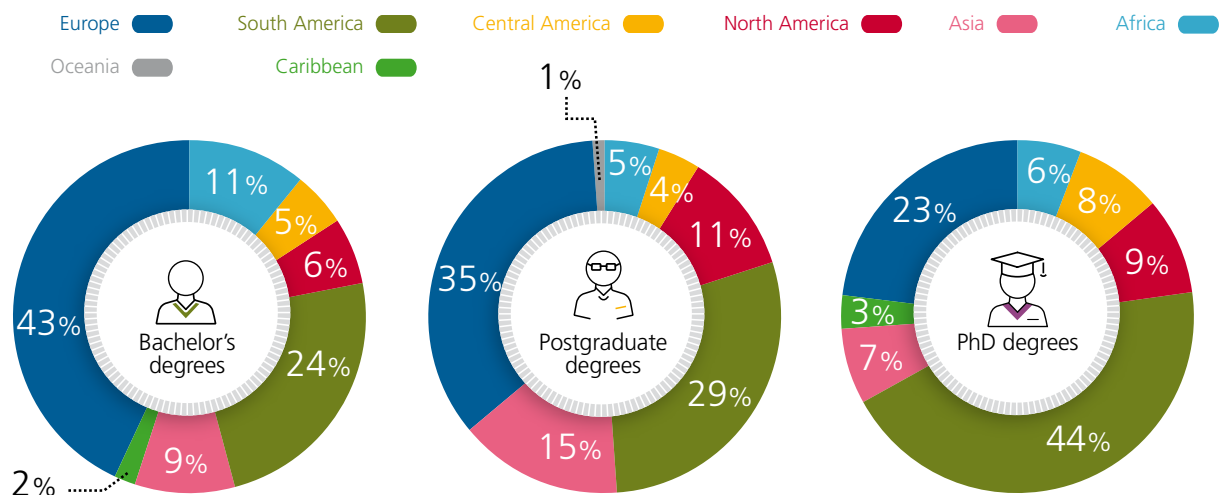

Spanish as a Foreign Language Courses

Semester and Summer Programmes for International Students

Semester, full year, and summer programmes for international students interested in areas related to Spanish language, culture, literature, business, marketing, global studies, or engineering. Courses are offered in Spanish and English, and students can combine them with language classes or with an internship in a company.



Customized Programmes

CIDE organizes customized courses and study abroad programmes (in the fields of language, global studies, education, business, human rights, health sciences, engineering). Both academic component of courses (contents, schedule, calendar) and complementary services (housing, excursions, advising) are organized with flexibility in order to respond to the needs of other universities and institutions.

Life on Campus

University life stretches beyond classrooms. It offers a wide variety of experiences to enjoy and grow within a lively community. Programmes on culture, sports, solidarity, and faith allow local and international students to engage in unique university experiences. All main services are offered on both campuses, nevertheless each campus has its own distinctiveness and specific atmosphere.

Housing Services

The University of Deusto offers a wide range of options for students and staff accommodation, from our lively Residence Hall, to home stay accommodation and shared flats.



The Buddy Programme (Deustokide)

Enables local and international students to meet people from different countries and immerse themselves in a new atmosphere, thus enhancing their university experience and above all, their personal experience.

Tandem Programme

Based on reciprocity, the Conversation Exchange was created in this context. It is free of charge and promotes independent learning between two people of different mother tongues, so they can learn from each other.



Language Courses

Offered to all the community: Spanish Courses, Spanish Courses for Specific Purposes, Individualized and customized courses, Instituto Cervantes Official Examination Board, Basque Language and Culture, and other foreign languages (Chinese, French, German, etc.).



Faith

As part of the global network of Jesuit institutions and universities, Deusto is committed to an education based on justice, leadership and vocation from the perspective of Ignatian principles that embrace and celebrate cultural and religious diversity, supporting a space for interreligious encounters and for the individual needs.
