ACADEMIC CALENDAR	From August 31 st , to July 6 th The academic year is divided into two semesters: *Autumn semester from September to December, January or February (depending on the faculty). *Spring semester from January or February to June or July (depending on the faculty) including the teaching and examination periods. Each faculty determines its own teaching and examination periods.	
APPLICATION PROCEDURE AND DEADLINES	After the nomination from the home institution, each student will receive the registration procedure by email. DEADLINES: *Autumn (odd) semester- Nomination: May 15th, receipt of application: May 31st. *Spring (even) semester- Nomination: November 1st, receipt of application: November 15th. For individual project work in a laboratory or for workshops: 6 weeks prior to the start of a project. Nomination of applicants should reach us 15 days in advance.	
LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS	Exchange students must be selected by their home institution and must get their language level evaluated before applying (OLS results and letters of recommendation written by teachers or professors are accepted). It is recommended to have a minimum level of language skills equal to B (independent user in understanding, speaking and writing), either B1-lower or B2-upper level, depending on the faculty.	
ACCOMMODATION	Accommodation available for international students at 4 halls of residence. Prices vary from 255€ up to 417€ per month depending on the size and the equipment. Online accommodation request must be sent along with the application: http://www.uphf.fr/RI/RI-Francais/vie-univ/demande-de-logement.htm Deadline for request: May 31st (Autumn semester) and November, 1st (Spring semester)	
LANGUAGE SUPPORT	Summer school prior to the start of classes: Intensive training sessions in French organized by the International Academy located in Lille (50 km distance, accessible by train), two weeks beginning mid-August (60hours, 600€). The UPHF offers free attendance for international students under the Erasmus+program. Details: http://www.cue-lillenorddefrance.fr/?q=international academy en During the year: French courses are offered (free of charge) by UPHF during the whole academic year (intermediate and advanced levels). FEES	For international exchange students: no fees for tuition, registration, examination and access to facilities such as laboratories, libraries or language centers. For double degree or degree students only : CVEC fees of 90 €.
