Founded in 1985, our University now offers 47 bachelor's degree programmes and 35 official master's degrees programmes, all of which are in accordance with the standards of the European Higher Education Area (EHEA). With around 8,000 students in accordance with the 2015 statistics, it offers a complete range of Bachelor's Degrees, Master's Degrees and other post-graduate studies for the best undergraduate and graduate education.

The Campus of Ciudad Real is divided into two venues: the main venue is, located in the city of Ciudad Real. A second venue is located in Almadén, a small town 100 kilometres away from Ciudad Real.

Taking advantage of the mercury mining tradition of Almadén, the UCLM decided to place the Polytechnic School, here where students can study the Bachelor's Degrees in Mining Engineering and Industrial Engineering. In addition, Almadén boasts the world's largest mercury mine, and together with Idrija, it is the only place that holds the Heritage of Mercury awarded by UNESCO back in 2012.
