

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS ASSESSMENT

The University of Florence offers more than 60 two-year graduate programs with no admission exam. Most of the graduate programs are taught in Italian, while some are completely taught in English. To be a candidate for a graduate degree, applicants must have completed an appropriate undergraduate degree program. Admission to graduate programs is based

on an evaluation of prior academic history: applicants have to submit to the assessment board of the major of their interest the official degree, the transcript of records and syllabus issued by the previous academic institution (See process described below). The prior academic background will be evaluated according to the requirements set by the board of professors of each graduate program.

- Bachelor's degree certificate
- Full transcript of academic records
- Subject descriptions (syllabus)
- CV
- Portfolio (only for students applying for programs of the Architecture School)

Please just send one email with the above listed documents as black and white .pdf files . All files together must not exceed 12 MB.

We just need the Italian or English part of the documents.

We neither accept files sent in a format different from .pdf or whose size exceed 12 MB, nor photos of the documents taken with smartphones/iphones, even if converted to .pdf.

Please note we are not allowed to download files from any website.
