Institutional overview	Xi'an Jiaotong-Liverpool University (XJTLU) is a unique Higher Education institution located in Suzhou, Jiangsu Province, China. It is the largest international collaborative university in China established in 2006 by its parent institutions, the University of Liverpool (UK) and Xi'an Jiaotong University (China). XJTLU is an independent University with degree awarding powers under the Chinese Ministry of Education. XJTLU enrolls Chinese students through the "Gaokao" national examination system (tier 1 students) and international students through independent admissions. XJTLU is situated on a purpose built campus in the Dushu Lake Higher Education Town at the heart of one of Asia's research and innovation hubs. Markers of XJTLU's quality can be seen through the high rankings of both of parent Universities; both nationally and internationally well regarded.

Taicang currently does not offer China Studies related modules.</i>

STUDENT ACCOMMODATION

All our students are guaranteed accommodation in our affordable student housing.

At Suzhou Industrial Park Campus (SIP), these are the Wenhua Apartments. Each single room has a double bed, a private bathroom, a study desk, a wardrobe, a TV, a balcony, and air conditioning. It costs 62RMB (\$11USD) per day, but this does not include electricity or water. Wenhua also has double room: these are the same size as the single rooms but have single-sized bunk beds for two occupants. It also costs 62RMB (\$11USD) per day for two students, not include electricity or water.

Accommodation at XJTLU Entrepreneur College (Taicang) is offered in one area next to the campus and is a 5 to 10-minute walk from the classrooms. There are two types of rooms: twin room (with two beds) and single room. Monthly rent is around 650 RMB for twin room and 1500 RMB for Single room.	
Application	Once students have received the Admissions Notice, they will then be sent the accommodation application web link via email.

Utilities	Utilities include electricity and water. Bills is run on a pay-as you-go system. Students should top up at the reception desk.

HEALTH AND INSURANCE

Public hospitals and insurance	The medical insurance provided by XJTLU covers treatment in public hospitals. Public hospitals in Suzhou are generally clean and reliable. Due to language barrier and different registration procedures in hospitals, students are advised to take a Chinese speaker with them or call XJTLU Global on 153 7145 1021 if language support is needed. Student need to keep all the receipts/invoices and paperwork related to the hospital visit in order to claim back the expenses, either against their own insurance or the one provided by XJTLU.
Private clinics	Private clinics are more foreigner-friendly. Doctors are generally either international or have a high standard of English. Treatment is entirely western medicine based. International clinics, for example, Jiahui Health, Sing Health Medical and NewLife Clinic, are significantly more expensive than public hospitals. The insurance provided by XJTLU can only cover up to 3,000 RMB in total in a year.
Dentists services	All major hospitals provide dentist services. The insurance provided by XJTLU only covers basic dental treatments. Cost for teeth beautification cannot be reimbursed.
Pharmacy	There are several pharmacies near XJTLU campus, both within 15 minutes' walk from campus. The pharmacies provide a range of Western and Chinese medicines. Staff don't speak English, so students should have the name of the medicine written in Chinese, or take a Chinese friend when they go. Students should always check the chemical name on the information sheet inside the box. Certain medicines may only be available in major hospitals or private clinics.

Appendix: Requirement of Admission

(1) Academic

Participating students shall be selected by your home institution, usually based on academic merit and suitability, and are subject to acceptance by Xi'an Jiaotong-Liverpool University (hereafter XJTLU) undertaking the normal admission procedures.

Students who nominated by home country are required to achieve the score in the following. Please notice that even in the same country, universities or institutions might have different marking system. Listed is just the one mainly inside the country.

The required score for a personal student sometimes will be higher or lower, depending on students' different education background.

(2) English

English is the language of instruction at XJTLU. Applicants for any undergraduate or postgraduate course of study, including Exchange/Visiting Students, whose first language is not English, should include an original or certified true copy of international English Certificate, such as:

You are exempted from proving your English proficiency when:

- Students who are nationals or who have previously completed an academic qualification equivalent to China High School degree, from a majority English-speaking country are automatically assumed to meet minimum English language requirements. These countries are: Antigua and Barbuda, Australia, Bahamas, Barbados, Belize, Canada, Dominica, Grenada, Guyana, Jamaica, New Zealand, St Kitts and Nevis, St Lucia, St Vincent and the Grenadines, Trinidad and Tobago, United Kingdom and the United States of America
- You have an English proficiency letter issued by your home university Language Centre (or equivalent unit) to proof you are in CEFR B2 Level.
- Any other international English Certificate which XJTLU recognizes.
