In order to get a quotation, please contact our representative for a personalized product. Assist Card may assist you with additional coverage due to travelling cancelation due to diagnosed COVID-19 on the student (some restrictions apply).

Some coverages of both policies include:

- Minimum coverage of \$50,000 USD (or its equivalent in other currencies) per accident or non-existing illness.
- Policies available in English or Spanish.
- Some coverages in the polcies include:
  - Zero deductible (Assist Card), zero copayment and direct payment to the Mexican hospital, not by refund to the patient (both policies).
  - Medical assistance in case of accidents.
  - First medical assistance in case of preexisting diagnosed illness.
  - Minor medical expenses
  - > Repatriation of remains
  - Sports and physical activities
  - Civil Liability
  - ➤ COVID-19 (some restrictions apply)
- ➤ List of hospitals in Mexico City in agreement with the insurance company where direct payment applies in case of urgency.
