

Module Selection Instructions for Incoming Exchange/Partner Visiting Students

At XJTLU we call the individual subjects that you will study modules. They are sometimes called classes or courses at other universities.

Students normally study 10-25 credits each semester. 25 credits is full study load of a degree student in XJTLU and equivalent to 37.5 ECTS.

Your module selections should have been approved by your home university before you submit them to XJTLU.

** Please notice that we have another campus which is in Taicang (1.5 hours' drive one-way from main campus). Students normally cannot select Taicang campus courses as transportation between two campuses are impossible, unless you choose all your modules/courses only in Taicang.*

Module selection procedure:

1. Round 1 (Pre-selection): You will be given login details. You will then be required to pre-select your modules in system. **You should select 40 credits as back up modules per semester or even more in order of preference, in case of time clashes or full classes.**
2. Round 2(Confirmation of module selection): You will be asked to check your timetable, drop off those modules that have timetable clashes in pre-selection, and **confirm the final list of modules you will be studying at XJTLU. Round 2 cannot select modules without in pre-selection pool. After you submit your selection in Round 2, system will confirm your final module timetable from Provisional to Enrollment.**
3. Make changes of modules selections: before end of Week 1, with special and reasonable reason, you can still make changes of your module selections if any of them are not the right level for you. But module empty spaces might be not enough, which students need to bear the risk. **Module changes will not be possible after semester begin of Week 2.**

Module catalogue and specifications:

1. Before receiving XJTLU student account:

Please look at our module catalogue and module specifications here: <http://modules.xjtlu.edu.cn/>: In the specifications of each module, you can see whether it is available in Semester 1 (Fall Semester) or Semester 2 (Spring Semester).

Domain Code ends with TC means the module is offered in Taicang Campus.

You will be using the previous year's module catalogue to select modules, so you need to be aware that some modules you select may not be running the following year when you study at XJTLU.

2. After Receiving XJTLU Account:

Students can log in Ebridge (Student Information system): https://ebridge.xjtlu.edu.cn/urd/sits.urd/run/siw_lgn:in the section "Academic-Curriculum-Module specification", if you input each module code, you can find more details of the module by yourself, including syllabus、 learning outcome、 mode of Delivery and hours、 assessment method and so on.

*** Before Round 2 Final Module Confirmation, it is students' obligation to check each module details in Ebridge to make sure you select the right modules.**

Modules for different levels:

The first number in the module code refers to the undergraduate level 0, 1, 2, and 3 at XJTLU. Undergraduate degree courses at XJTLU are 4 years with a general education level 0. Degree specific content is taught according to the 3 year UK norm at XJTLU level 1, 2 and 3:

The first number for Master's modules is 4.

The first number for non-credit-bearing modules is 9.

Restrictions:

1. An exchange/partner visiting student can study max. 1 Chinese Language module (CLT module) each semester, either 5 credits or 10 credits.
2. The following modules are not available for exchange/visiting students:
 - All CCT modules
 - All PHE modules
 - Level 0 modules, except CCS (China Studies), CLT (Chinese language), JPL (Japanese language) and SPA (Spanish language) modules.
3. Master's modules are not available for undergraduate students.
4. Domain Code ends with TC means the module is offered in Taicang Campus. Some Taicang modules are subject "cannot" choose base on the nature of industry entrepreneurship.
5. Taicang modules are not open for SIP main campus students, vice versa.
6. Some special modules such as IMBA/Professional Accounting modules/PG ESS modules cannot be selected.
