Application procedure

Step 0. Universities nominate students by email before the deadline (30 April, 30 September).

Students should make sure they have been nominated before applying.

Students will receive precise guidelines on how to apply after their nomination and before the application deadline

Step 1. Requesting User and Password

Step 2. Fill in the online application form

Step 3. Confirm the application

Step 4. Download and print the overview of the online application. Obtain the signature and upload it along with:

- Motivation letter
- Copy of transcript of records
- Language certificates for Spanish and/or English

Other remarks

Language requirements

- For classes taught in Spanish: Spanish B1
- For classes taught in English: English B2 + A2 Spanish (Direct exchange students are exempted of Spanish A2)
- For project supervised in English: English B2
- For project supervised in Spanish: Spanish B2

CEFR Official certificates or accredited by the home institution are requested

Bachelor or Master Thesis/Project

- Supervised by a lecturer from ETSII
- Must be defended at ETSII
- Conducted along with courses or as the core academic activity of the semester.

Relevant information (!)

Please, regard the next points when planning the Learning Agreement:

- The minimum load per semester is 20 ECTS (including Bachelor/Master thesis); however, we recommend 30 ECTS per semester
- The language level must be proved during the online application period. However, if students cannot provide it, they will have to submit a commitment to upload the requested language level before the start of the mobility
- Students can take courses from other UPV schools (Business Administration School excluded), but no more than 12 ECTS or 2 courses (6 ECTS or 1 course for Direct Exchange and SICUE students)
- Please pay attention to the semester that the course belongs to (A or B). There are also annual courses
- Our School does not assume any responsibility for any inconvenience caused by a wrong choice of courses (a different semester, an overlap of schedules, an overlap of exam dates, etc.)
- Courses taught at UPV campuses of Gandia and Alcoy are not available, since these campuses are 65 and 110 km away from Valencia, respectively
- Availability of courses cannot be confirmed until the first days of the semester

Relevant information (!)

- Many courses have laboratory practices whose attendance is compulsory to take the exam
- For every semester there are usually two mid-term exams and a final exam, which is a retake one in most of the cases
- It is a rule in our School not to make any exception with the exam dates or procedures of evaluation, not even for exchange students. Hence, exam can only be taken in the official dates and they can't be sent via email or fax
- Before the start of each semester, there is available an optional Fee-paying - 40-hour – 4 ECTS intensive Spanish course in Gandia campus (60 km away from Valencia). Students can obtain an attendance certificate, but it does not grant a specific level
