Visa

Non-EU/EEA students are responsible for getting a study visa prior to entering Romania.

RAU will apply to the Ministry of National Education and Scientific Research for the Letter of Acceptance. Once it will be issued and sent to the students, they may apply for a study visa at the closest Romanian embassy prior to their arrival.

Residence permit

After arrival, both EU/EEA and non-EU/EEA students must apply for a residence certificate/residence permit at the Immigration Office in Bucharest in 2-month time. It will take 30 days for the residence permit to be issued.

Mandatory Health insurance

For EU/EEA students, EU health insurance card is available.

Also, students may choose to purchase their health insurance either from their home country or directly in Romania.
