Minimum credits	Fulltime studies are 30 ECTS per semester. In order to be guaranteed student accommodation, students need to be admitted to a minimum of 15 ECTS per semester at Mid Sweden University.
Language requirements	Certification of English proficiency is not required for exchange students from partner universities.
Language courses (Swedish)	"Swedish language for foreign students" 7.5 ECTS may be taken in addition to other courses. The course is free of charge.
Course registration	Course registration opens a few days before the course starts. Students register for their courses upon arrival.
Disability services	Support for students with disabilities must be arranged by the home institution before arrival. There are different types of support offered at Mid Sweden University: https://www.miun.se/en/student/service-and-support/studera-med-funktionshinder/
Visa requirements for non- european exchange students	Student must be admitted to fulltime studies (30 ECTS) at Mid Sweden University to apply for residence permit. Student jobs	Exchange students and students with a study visa are allowed to work alongside their studies. Please note that it may be difficult to find work if you do not speak Swedish.
