Study options: Students can come for the full year (two semesters) or one semester, fall or spring.

Institutional Description	With the primary aim of raising the human and social condition of men and women in Mexico and around the world, in 1964, the Universidad Anáhuac is founded in its temporary location of Lomas Virreyes, in the Mexico City. In 1968 it opens its first permanent campus at Interlomas, Huixquilucan muni- cipality, State of Mexico.  From the consolidation of this first University, the commitment to complete-ly form an increasingly large number of students was continuously pursued with great dynamism, driving the emergence and integration of the rest of the institutions that now make up the Anáhuac Universities Network.  The Universidad Anáhuac Querétaro begins its administrative duties in 2005 with 6 degrees. A year later classes began with an enrollment of 159 students. On August 9, 2010 it is moved to the first building of its new campus of 20 hectares.
	Since then the University has had a constant growth, which is reflected in the current enrollment.

# STUDENT EXCHANGE REQUIREMENTS

General Requirements	Be a regular student at the home university. Have a satisfactory academic performance. Have completed at least 50% of the whole academic program.
Language requirements (for courses delivered in Spanish)	For exchange students we require a B2 level of Spanish in order to be able to follow the lectures. Students need to present a DELE certificate (level B2) or a document issued by the University Language Department of the home institution.
General Requirements	For English language lectures we require language certificate level 6.5 IELTS, 89 points TOEFL (iBT) or a document issued by the University Language Department of the home institution.
General Requirements	After receiving students' nominations from their home university we will send the application form. Students will need to fill in the form and submit it together with the attachments mentioned in Section 5 ("List of Documents") of the Application Form.
