

To facilitate the integration of knowledge from both the university and research institutes, WUR has an innovative campus that is designed to stimulate interaction between students, professors and researchers.


General information and requirements

- Students can apply for a short term exchange at WUR in accordance with a bilateral agreement, Erasmus programme or other exchange agreement for study. The Exchange Office is not involved with work and internship for incoming students.
- Student exchange is only possible if there is an agreement between WUR and your educational institution. Ask your exchange coordinator if this is the case.
- You need to be eligible to participate in the exchange programme, your educational institution selects and nominates the candidates for student exchange.
- Preferably you have completed 120 ECTS, which equals at least two years of study at the home university/ academic background.
- Fluency in English, both written and spoken, is required (minimum B2 proficiency).

Wageningen Town

WUR is centrally located in the Netherlands. Amsterdam, Rotterdam and The Hague are only an hour's travel by train. All university facilities and the city center are within cycling distance. There are historic and modern buildings, high-rise student flats, works of art and botanical gardens. Students, accounting for 20% of the population, turn Wageningen into a university town.

Wageningen has a thriving cultural and social life. Theatres, cinemas, student clubs, bars, night life and restaurants offer the excitement of a city with the safe environment of a rural village. The many international students, professors and researchers contribute to the international atmosphere. Wageningen is delightfully 'green', being surrounded by farmland, forests, nature reserves and the summer meadows of the Rhine river.





International character

WUR has an excellent international reputation. More than 50% of the BSc courses and all MSc courses are taught in English. WUR is again worldwide ranked in 2019 the number one university in the field of agriculture sciences.

Many students are interested in a wide range of topics. Choosing a minor gives you the opportunity to broaden your knowledge and competencies. Exchange students from partner universities have the possibility to follow a minor at WUR. Minors consist of sets of courses of 24 ECTS with coherence and profundity. Minors are scheduled in either the first or the second semester of the academic year.
